CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BYE LAWS of the Council of the City of Montreal concerning the appropriation of the necessary sums of money to meet the expenditure now carried on in taking of levels, etc. and for other

objects.

(Submitted and read 1st time, 7 nov., 2d time, 14 nov. 3d. time, 21 november.)

The Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Montreal, duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the
City of Montreal, on saturday the twenty fist day of november One thousand eight hundred and forty, in virtue of the
authority vested in them, in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the Province of Lower Canada and the Special Counwill for the Affairs of the said Province, made and passed in
the fourth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled: "An Ordinance to incorporate the City of Montreal".

Section 1---That a sum of Five Hundred Pounds currency be appropriated to pay the expenses and disbursments incurred and to be incurred in taking of Levels, examination of common Sewers and other Works ordered by the Council.
Section 2--- And be it further ordained and enacted that a sum of Bighty Founds currency be appropriated to pay the rent of the City Hall from the first of november instant until the first day of May next, and that a further sum of Four Hundred Pounds said currency be appropriated for the fitting up and providing furniture and firewood for the said City Hall.--
