to suspend certain regulations respecting

The MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council, at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on Saturday the eighth day of May in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty one, by virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the <sup>Governor of the</sup> late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province, made and passed in the fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled: "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal", and also by another and subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign and intituled: "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

DO ORDAIN AND ENACT and it is <sup>hereby</sup> Ordained and enacted

That from and after the passing of this By-Law all rules and regulations respecting the Licensing and the exaction of fees for licensing of carters within the said City shall be and the same are hereby annulled and rescinded.-
