REGLEMENT MUNICIPAL no 30.
3 juin 1841

CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BYE-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal vesting in the Members of the Road Committee, appointed by the Council of the said City, certain powers and authorities formerly exercised by the Justices of the Peace in certain cases therein mentioned.

Submitted and read 1st and 2d time on 29th May and a 3d time on the 3d June 1841.

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on thursday the third day of June in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty one by virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province, made and passed in the fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign intituled: "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal" and also by another subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

WHEREAS in and by a certain Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province, made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of

Montreal", it is amongst other things ordained and enacted that all and every the powers and authorities which were at the time of the passing of the said Ordinance by law vested in the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the District of Montreal and in any special sessions of the Peace for the said District or in any of them for touching or concerning the laying out, making, erecting, keeping in repair and regulating the highways, bridges, streets, squares, causeways, pavements, drains, ditches, embankments, water courses, sewers or any of them, and from and after the passing of the said Ordinance become and are vested in and can be exercised by the said Council of the said City.-

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority aforesaid that all and every the powers and authorities vested in and exercised by any one Justice of the Peace respecting the regulating of the highways, bridges, streets, squares, lanes, causeways, pavements, drains, ditches, embankments, water courses, sewers or any of them shall be and hereby ^{are} vested in and shall be exercised by any one of the members of the Road Committee appointed by the said Council and more especially as to enjoining and ordering the filling up of ^etroughs and the making of pavement or ground broken up, and as to fixing the time when the same shall be done and all other duties or authorities vested by law in any one of the said Justices respecting the purposes aforesaid.-
