REGLEMENT MUNICIPAL no 8
23 janvier 1841

CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BYE LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal

concerning the appropriation of the necessary sum of money required to contract for a sufficient quantity of broken Stone to Macadamize the Roads therein mentioned.--

(Submitted and read 1st time 7th January 1841,
 " 2d time, 11th Janu., and
 " 3d time, 23d, January 1841)

The Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on Saturday the twenty third day of January in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty one, in virtue of the authority vested in them, in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the Affairs of the said Province, made and passed in the fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled: "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal," DO ORDAIN and ENACT, and it is hereby ordained and enacted:-

Section 1--- That the Streets and Roads herein after mentioned and enumerated be macadamized in a proper and efficient manner under the direction and superintendance of the Road Committee of this Council, viz.-

1st- Saint Mary street of the Quebec Suburb from Dalhousie Square to the City Boundary;

2d- Saint Lawrence street, in the Saint Lawrence Suburbs, from Craig street to the City Boundary;

3d- Saint Joseph street, in the Saint Joseph Suburbs, from the Hay Market to the City Boundary, on the La-chine Road;

4th- The Road leading from the Hay Market along Saint Antoine street to Guy street, and from thence along Guy and Provost streets to the City Boundary on the Road to Côte des Neiges; And

5th- Commissioners street fronting the Wharves from Port street to the ~~New~~ Market.--

Section 2---- And be it further ordained and enacted that the Road Committee be authorized and it is hereby authorized and empowered to contract for a sufficient quantity of broken Stones for the purpose mentioned in the preceding Section, and the Treasurer is hereby empowered and directed to advance out of the monies which may now be or shall hereafter come into his hands, the sum of Three Thousand One Hundred Pounds currency at such times and in such sums as may be required by the said Committee for the purpose of carrying this Bye Law into effect.--
