REGLEMENT MUNICIPAL no 55
7 janvier 1842

CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal
appropriating the sum of SIX THOUSAND POUNDS
for public improvements.

Submitted and read 1st and 2d times on 24th Dec. 1841
and 3d time on 7th January 1842.

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on Friday the seventh day of January in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty two, in virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal" and also by another subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

DO ORDAIN AND ENACT and it is hereby ordained
and enacted:

SECTION 1

That the further sum of SIX THOUSAND POUNDS be appropriated for the purpose of providing materials and making other necessary preparations during this winter for the completion of works already authorized by the said Council and that the said sum be expended under the direction of the Committee of Roads and Improvements and to be hereafter accounted for.
