REGLEMENT MUNICIPAL no 59, 7 janvier 1842

CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal establishing the amount of fee for affiging the Seal of the Corporation.

Submitted and read 1st,2d and 3d times on 7th January 1842.

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City
of Montreal, on friday the seventh day of January One thousand eight hundred and forty two, by virtue of the authority
vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor
of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council
for the affairs of the said Province made and passed in the
fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal" and
also by another subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor
and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of
Her said Majesty's intituled" An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

DO ORDAIN AND ENACT and it is hereby ordained and enacted that there shall be paid by any person or persons who shall desire the seal of the Corporation of the said City to be affixed to any document whatsoever in which the said Corporation shall be in nowise interested, the sum of five shillings, which said sum shall be paid to the City Clerk at the time of his affixing the said Seal.-
