CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal
to increase the salary of the Clerk of the
Hay Market on Commissioners square and
also that of his assistant.

Submitted and read 1st and 2d times on 6th April
and 3d time on 14th April, 1842.

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on thursday the fourteenth^{day} of April in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty two by virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal" and by a subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

WHEREAS the duties of the Clerk of the Hay Market on Commissioners square and that of his assistant require that the salaries they have heretofore received should be augmented be it therefore ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained and enacted that from and after the first day of March last past the said Clerk and said assistant be paid and received for their services in the offices aforesaid at the following rates: the Clerk, one hundred and twenty five pounds, and the said assistant seventy five pounds currency per annum.--
