CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal
to increase the salary of the Clerk of the
New Market in the said City.

Submitted and read 1st and 2d times on 14th March
and 3d time on the 30th day of March 1842.

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on wednesday the thirtieth day of March in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty two, by virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal", and also by a subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

WHEREAS the recently increased duties and responsibility of the Clerk of the New Market in this City require that the salary he has heretofore received should be augmented, be it therefore ordained and enacted and itb is hereby ordained and enacted that *f*rom and after the first day of March instant the said Clerk of the New Market be paid and receive for his services in the office aforesaid at the rate of Two Hundred Pounds currency per annum.--
