REGLEMENT MUNICIPAL no. 48

CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal appropriating the sum of Four Hundred Pounds to pay E.M.Loprohon, esquire, for property.

Submitted and read lst and 2d times on 29th Sept., and 3d time on 18 th October 1841.

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on monday the eighteenth day of October in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty one, in virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majosty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal" and also by another subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign and intituled: "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

WHEREAS it is necessary for the improving and widening of Lagauchetiere and St-Radegonde streets to acquire a portion of the property belonging to E.M.Leprohon, esquire, situated on the said Streets, and WHEREAS it appears by the award of Arbitrators appointed to determine the value and compensation to be paid for the said portion of property that the said Arbitrators have awarded the sum of Four Hundred Pounds as the value and compensation to be paid the said E.M. Leprohon for the said portion of property and all damages whatsoever.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained and enacted that the sum of Four Hundred Pounds be and the same is hereby appropriated for payment of the price of and as compensation for the said portion of property belonging to the said E.M.Leprohon.
