REGLEMENT MUNICIPAL no 44
14 août 1841

CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal
appropriating a certain sum of money to the
representatives of the late Honorable
PIERRE de ROCHEBLAVE.

Submitted and read 1st time 9th, 2d and 3d
times 14th August 1841.

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on saturday the fourteenth day of August in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty one, in virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal" and also by another subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

WHEREAS in and by a certain agreement entered into by a Committee of the Justices of the Peace for the District of Montreal, resident within the City of Montreal and submitted to and approved of by a meeting of the said Justices held in the said City on the second day of June one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight, it appears among other things that the late Honorable Pierre de Rocheblave in his life time of Montreal, esquire, ceded and transferred to the City of Montreal five feet of land along the whole of the orchard possessed by

by him in St-Alexander street in the said City gratis and without payment for the same and sold eleven feet more on the said line for the consideration of One Hundred and Twenty Five Pounds currency for each square lot of three thousand two hundred feet since such sale taken possession of by the said City and WHEREAS the sum of Seventy Eight Pounds fourteen shillings and one penny was due and payable on the third day of June last by the said City to Anne Elmire Bouthillier, widow of the said late Honorable Pierre de Rocheblave, and Tancrede Bouthillier of the same Place, esquire, in their capacity of executors of the last will of the said late Pierre de Rocheblave deceased for the said purchase,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained and enacted that the sum of Seventy Eight Pounds fourteen shillings and one penny be and the same is hereby appropriated for the payment due to the said Anne Elmire Bouthillier and Tancrede Bouthillier in their capacity of Executors of the last will of the said Pierre de Rocheblave deceased for the reasons aforesaid.-
