REGLEMENT MUNICIPAL no 79-
1 août 1842

CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

--

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal
appropriating a certain sum of money to pay for
a piece of ground belonging to the Hon. Fred.
Auguste Quesnel for the widening of St-
François-Xavier street.

Submitted and read 1st and 2d times on 23d July
and a 3d time on monday 1st August 1842.

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on monday the first day of August in the year of Our lord One thousand eight hundred and forty two, by virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal", and by a subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

WHEREAS for the purpose of widening and improving St-François-Xavier street in the said City it was by a resolution in Council determined to purchase obtain and acquire possession of a certain portion, to wit, fifty five feet one inch in front by an average depth of five feet six inches of a certain lot of ground situated on the said street belonging to the Hon. Frederick Auguste Quesnel and that for the purpose of determining the value thereof and the price to be given therefore

a jury should be empannelled in the manner prescribed by the Ordinance 4 Vict.chap.32, And WHEREAS the said Jury empannelled as aforesaid have determined the value of the said portion of the said lot of ground and the price or compensation to be given therefor at the sum of One Hundred and Twenty Three Pounds current money of the Province of Canada, BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained and enacted that the said sum of One Hundred and Twenty Three Pounds, current money aforesaid, be and the same is hereby appropriated and placed at the disposal of the Road Committee of the said Council to pay and compensate the said hon. Frederick Auguste Quesnel for the said portion of the said lot of ground so as aforesaid required to be purchased, obtained and taken possession of for the purpose of widening and improving the said street.-
