CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal

repealing part of a By-Law and fixing the amount
of salary to be allowed the City Clerk.

Submitted and read 1st and 2d time on 26th Sept.
and 3d time on 24th October 1842.

WHEREAS experience has shown that the duties of the
Clerk of the City of Montreal are more ~~numerous~~ numerous and difficult
than they were at first presumed to be,-

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Mont-
real duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City
of Montreal, on monday the twenty fourth day of October in
the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty two
in virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordi-
nance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada
and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province
made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majesty's
Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and
Town of Montreal" also by a subsequent Ordinance of the said
Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth
year of Her said Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to
amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Mont-
real",

DO ORDAIN AND ENACT and it is hereby ordained and enact-
ed,

SECTION 1

That the second section of the By-Law No 1 heretofore
passed by the Council of the City of Montreal on the seventh
day of November which was in the year of Our Lord one thou-

sand eight hundred and forty and intituled: "By-Law concerning the salaries of the Mayor and officers of the Corporation" be and the same is hereby repealed,

SECTION 2

And be it further ordained and enacted that the sum of Four Hundred Pounds currency be and the same is hereby appropriated and allowed as the salary of the said City Clerk and as compensation for his services in that capacity from and since the first day of May now last past and the said salary of Four Hundred Pounds currency per annum shall be hereafter allowed and paid monthly to him the said City Clerk in lieu of all fees and perquisites of office.-
