REGLEMENT MUNICIPAL no 91 24 octobre 1842

CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal
authorizing the purchase of a strip of land
from the Reverend Gentlemen of the Seminary
of St-Sulpice in the City aforesaid and
compensation to them for removal of the
stone wall on the Cotes des Neiges
Road.-

Submitted and read 1st time and 2d time on 17th Oct.and 3d time on 24th October 1842.

WHEREAS for the purpose of widening and improving the ascent to the Mountain within the City limits by the Cote des Neiges Road, it hath been resolved to purchase and obtain from the Rev. Gentlemen of the Seminary of St-Sulpice in this City a strip of land along the line of the said Road of Twenty feet in breadth by about twelve acres in lenght beginning at the northern angle of the Mountain fort and extending as far as the City limits, and further to compensate and pay to the Gentlemen of the Seminary aforesaid, the expense of removing and extending the stone wall by which the said Road is bounded.—

THE MAYOR, ALDERGEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montare real duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on monday the twenty fourth day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand wight hundred and forty two, in virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal" also by a subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the

fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal",

enacted that His Honor the Mayor of the said City be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to purchase the said strip of land from the Gentlemen of the Seminary aforesaid and to allow them as the price and consideration thereof and for the expense of removing and extending the stone wall by which the same id bounded the sum of Two Hundred Pounds current money of the Province of Canada payable with interest in twenty years from the day of the date thereof, and that for, the said sum of Two Hundred Pounds current money aforesaid payable as aforesaid in twenty tears from the day of the date hereof, Hid Honor the Mayor aforesaid is hereby authorized and empowered to issue a Corporation Bond or Bonds to and in favour of the said Gentlemen Ecclesiastics aforesaid.--
