REGLEMENT MUNICIPAL no 93
24 octobre 1842

CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Montreal
authorizing the construction of a drain or sewer
in Fortification Lane for the benefit of
certain proprietors in Little St-James
street.-

Submitted and read 1st and 2d times on 17th Oct.,
and 3d time on 24th October 1842.

WHEREAS on the petition of divers proprietors in Little St-James street, it hath been resolved on certain terms and conditions hereinafter stated to continue the drain in Fortification Lane from its present termination opposite to M. Shakel's property to a point opposite the extremity of the property of Nicol Hugh Baird and wife, two of the said Petitioners.-

THE MAYOR, ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS of the City of Montreal duly assembled in Council at the City Hall, in the City of Montreal, on monday the twenty fourth day of October in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty two, in virtue of the authority vested in them in and by an Ordinance of the Governor of the late Province of Lower Canada and the Special Council (for the affairs of the said Province) made and passed in the fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal" also by a subsequent Ordinance of the said Governor and Special Council made and passed in the fourth year of Her said Majesty's Reign intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance to incorporate the City and Town of Montreal"

DO ORDAIN AND ENACT and it is hereby ordained and enacted that

the Road Committee of the said Council be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to continue the said drain or sewer in Fortification lane aforesaid from its said termination opposite to Shakels property to a point opposite to the said property of the said Nicol Hugh Baird and wife provided that the proprietors of lands, lots and houses in the said street to whom and to whose premises along the said continuation of the said drain or sewer can be serviceable do contribute and pay one half the expense thereof for the contribution and payment thereof the said proprietors are hereby assessed, and provided further that the said proprietors do contribute and advance the remaining half of the expense of the continuation of the said drain or sewer as a loan to the said Council on interest for five years, the interest whereof to be payable half yearly.-
