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CORPORATION OF MONTREAL

BY-LAW to impose a special tax or assessment on
real estate in the said City for School
purposes.-

WHEREAS it is provided in and by a certain Act passed at the last session of the Legislature of the Province of Quebec entitled: "An Act to amend the law respecting Education in this Province" that "the Corporations of the Cities of Quebec and Montreal shall pay annually for the support of the Schools in the said Cities a sum equal to three times the amount of the share of the Government grant coming to the Schools of the said Cities under the provisions of the said Act",

And WHEREAS it is further enacted in and by the said Act that "the Corporations of the Cities of Quebec and Montreal shall levy annually by assessment on real estate in the said Cities a tax sufficient to cover the amount payable by them for the support of schools under the provisions of the said Act",

At a Special Meeting of the Council of the City of Montreal held in the City Hall of the said City, this thirtieth day of April in the now year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, under and by virtue of the Act of the Provincial Legislature 14 and 15 Victoria ch. 128, in the manner and after the observance of all the formalities prescribed in and by the said Act, at which said Meeting not less than two-thirds of the members of the Council, to wit: the following members thereof are present, viz: His Worship the Mayor William Workman, esquire, ALDERMEN: David, Valois, Munro Rodden, Devlin, Bernard, Alexander, COUNCILLORS: McGauvran, Taylor, McShane, Wilson, Lyman, Thomson, G.W. Stephens, Simard, Leduc, St-

Charles, Jordan, Plinguet, Roy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the said Council and the said Council do hereby ordain and enact as follows:

SEC.1-- An annual tax of eight cents for every one hundred dollars of the assessed value of real estate in the said City of Montreal is hereby imposed on all real estate lying and being within the said City of Montreal liable to assessment under the provisions of the said above first cited Act over and above all existing rates, taxes or assessments already imposed by the By-Laws of the said Council, and the proceeds of the said special tax shall be applied exclusively to the support of schools in the said City according to law.-

SEC.2-- The said special tax shall become due and payable annually by the owner or owners of real estate in the said City liable to assessment under the provisions of the said above first cited Act from the first day of May⁺ soon as the return of the assessment roll for the several Wards of the said City of Montreal respectively shall have been made to the City Treasurer.-

SEC.3-- The said special tax or assessment shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of the said City of Montreal, and in default of payment of the same shall be recovered in the same manner as the annual assessment in the said City of Montreal for municipal purposes.-

SEC.4-- The By-Law number eighteen passed by the said Council on the eleventh day of November last is hereby repealed.-
