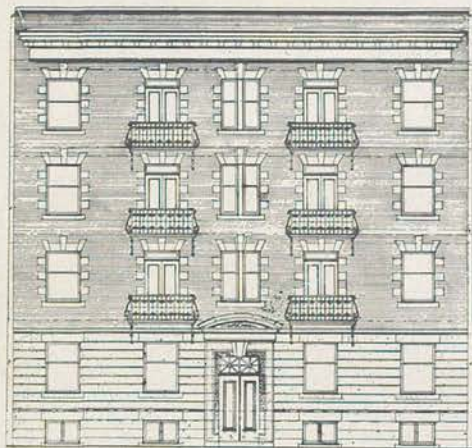

M. N. Lapointe naquit en 1849 à Saint-Michel de Bellechasse. A l'âge de 16 ans, il se dirigeait vers les Etats-Unis, où il pratiquait le métier de machiniste à New-York et à Boston. A 22 ans il revint à Montréal où pendant 18 mois il continua d'exercer son métier. En 1875, il fonda l'important commerce d'épicerie qu'il dirige encore aujourd'hui. Très populaire dans son quartier, il fut élu représentant du quartier St-Joseph en 1902; après 4 ans de politique municipale, M. Lapointe se décidait à quitter son siège, mais six jours après sa résignation, il se voyait offrir la candidature de Sainte-Cunégonde, alors récemment annexée à Montréal, et reprenait de nouveau la route de l'hôtel-de-ville, chargé du mandat de ses nouveaux électeurs, qu'il représente encore aujourd'hui.

M. Lapointe a épousé en 1872 Mademoiselle Azilda Verdon et est aujourd'hui l'heureux père d'une famille de quatre enfants.

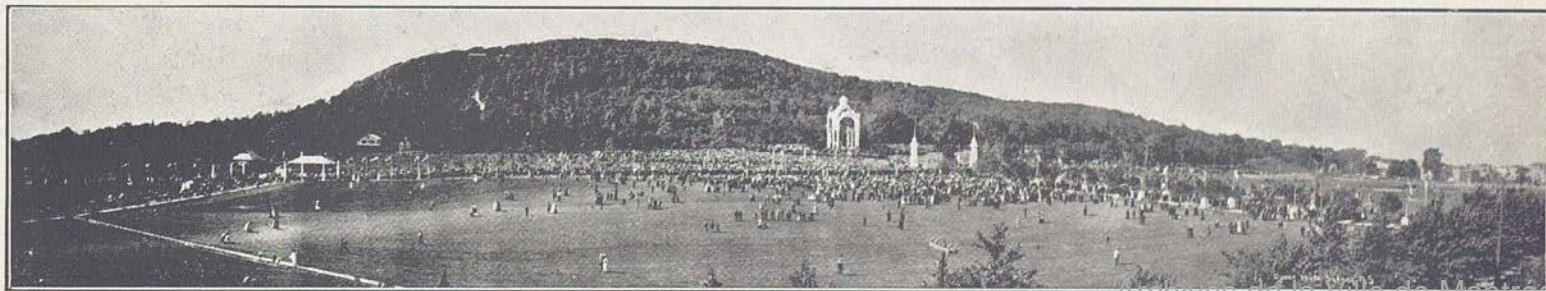

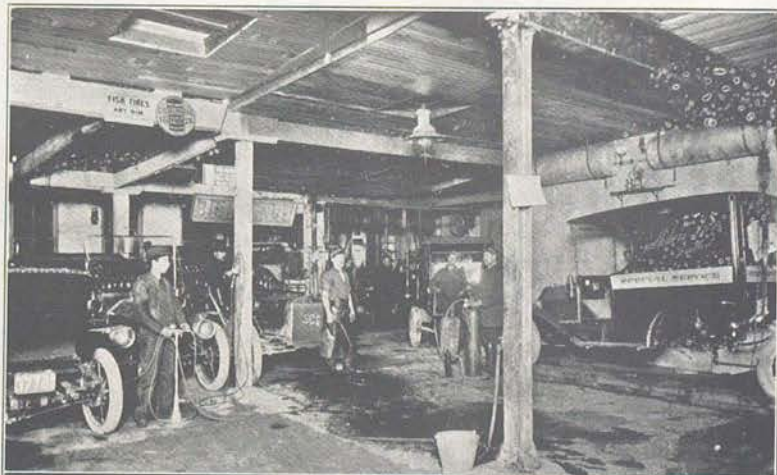
PANORAMIC VIEW OF MOUNT ROYAL FROM Mr. DAOUST'S RESIDENCE
