detailed make the length of the enlar-  
gement and improvement of the  
Chambly canal to be  $8\frac{7}{8}$  Miles,  
and the length of the new Canal  
to be  $23\frac{62}{100}$  Miles, and the whole  
length of the St. Lawrence & Lake  
Champlain Canal  $32\frac{1}{2}$  Miles."



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
