RESOLVED: That five hundred pounds per arpent be offered to H.L. Routh Esquire for the land required from him on the line of the pipe track of the New Reservoir.

E X T R A C T

from the minutes of a meeting of the Water Committee of the City of Montréal held on the 23rd of November 1853.

RESOLVED: To notify the Hon. Mr. Quesnel that the Water Department will require a portion of land from him for the pipe track of the rising main water pipe of the New Reservoir and will take possession of it immediately by paying him one thousand Pounds for the expropriation of his land.

RESOLVED: To notify also the Hon. George Moffatt that the Water Department will require a small strip of land from him for the same object as that required from Mr. Quesnel and will pay him One hundred and fifty pounds for the expropriation of his property.
