The Memorial of John Lilly of Montreal
aforesaid Merchant, humbly sheweth -

That Your Memorialist apprehending that incon-
veniences may arise to himself and to the neighbourhood of his premises,
from the actual state of the Drain, or Sewer, conducting the
water from his dwelling House to the River St. Laurence, it
being in want of repair; begs leave to solicit the permission
of your Worships; to have as much of the pavement in
St. Joseph Street (facing the East Front of his premises) taken
up; so that he may have the said Drain properly examined
and repaired; for which purpose, the permission of Your Worships
being obtained, Your Memorialist will employ sufficient work-
men to complete the defects and replace the pavement with
expedition, so that as little inconvenience to the public may
be occasioned ~~to the~~ as possible -
