 Amount of the Surplus funds, and the
 apportionment thereof, in conformity with
 the provisions of these Acts

That as no Accounts have been rendered
of the due application of the sums, previously
paid to that Church, out of these funds, as
required by the 9th Sec. of the Act 3 & 4 Vict.
cap 78, the payment of the portions due to
that Church for the past year cannot be
recommended,

The Church of Scotland have rendered
Accounts of the expenditure of sums received
for the years 1845 & 6, with the exception of
the balance of £ 7878.19.3 which remained
unexpended on 3rd January ulto. the date of the
last Account. How far these Accounts
are sufficiently detailed to meet the require-
ments of the Law is submitted.
