 Personally appeared Mr. Samuel Morin of the said  
 City Merchant, and made the following Declaration Viz.  
 That Mr. Francis Rybot, of London in Great Britain  
 Merchant, by his Letter of Attorney dated in London the  
 fifteenth day of April in this present year, and duly authen-  
 -ticated by Abram Ogier of the same place Notary, having  
 constituted and appointed him this appear and Mr.  
 Sigismund Dubuit of this City to be his Lawfull Attornies  
 to act jointly for the benefit of his the said Francis Rybot's  
 concerns in Canada, agreeable to the orders of the said Francis  
 Rybot, signified to the said Sigismund Dubuit and this  
 appearer; That this Appearer being Attorney as aforesaid,  
 and being willing and desirous to act in conformity to the  
 Instructions of the said Constituent, hath made frequent  
 application to the said Sigismund Dubuit, the other  
 Attorney, and demanded a State of the accounts relative  
 to the affairs of the said Francis Rybot, in Canada aforesaid,  
 which the said Sigismund Dubuit has not yet produced,



whereby the Interest of the said Francis Rybot is greatly  
Injured; As also the particular Interest of this appearer.  
In Consideration whereof I the said Notary by the  
desire of said appearer went to the Lodging of the said  
Sigmund Dubuit in the lower town of Quebec aforesaid,  
And did then and then Request of him to deliver to this  
appearer an account Sales of all the Goods he received from  
Jean or John Jennison Mentioned for the proper account of

Taylor, from London, Accounts Current with all persons

Notary at the Request aforesaid did and do hereby  
Solemnly Protest against the said Sigmund  
Dubuit for all Damages, Losses, Expences, Hindrances,  
Delays, Detentions Interest and Charges suffered or to be  
suffered, accrued or which may hereafter accrue to the Interest  
and Concerns of the said Francis Rybot, howsoever, whatsoever  
or whencesoever for and on account of the Refusal of the said  
Sigmund Dubuit with the legal Request of this  
appearer
