

THE PROVINCIAL EXHIBITION,
MONTREAL.

The Provincial Exhibition at Montreal, opened on the 14th and closed on the 23d of September, was in every way a most successful affair.

The exhibition was the subject of the various committees, including a grand military review, croquet matches, bicycle tournament, and a grand parade of the first brigade, and various other sports, which attracted greatly to the exhibition.
