EXTRACT of the minutes of a Special meeting of the Council of the City of Montréal held, Wednesday, 2nd July, 1902.

THE ROAD COMMITTEE
respectfully report.

That they have duly considered the annexed report from the City Surveyor anent the offer of the Quebec Government to rent to the City at a nominal rental of One Dollar per annum, the lot of land situated between the City Hall and the Court House on condition that the said lot of land be kept in good repair by the City.

That by the said report it appears that the lot of land in question is much used by the public, but the City is unable to repair it as it is not City property.

Therefore after due deliberation, Your Committee recommends that the annexed draft of lease, by which the City would become the lessee of the said lot of land for a period of Nine years, be approved by the Council and that His Worship the Mayor and the City Clerk be authorized to sign the same on behalf of the City.

I beg to attach you herewith an offer from the Quebec Government of a piece of land on the West side of the City Hall, called Jacques Cartier Square, on condition that the City pays a rental of \$1.00 per year, and that we keep the Square in good order.

In reply I to this I would say that this piece of land is very much used by the City, but under the existing Charter we are unable to keep it in order as it is not City property, but if the above agreement is entered into with the Quebec Government we will be in a position to repair it legally.
