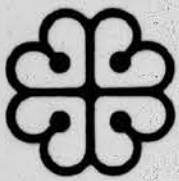


Dear Sir:

You are no doubt aware, from the news media or from declarations made in the Legislative Assembly, that a Provincial Civil Protection Organization was recently created.

It is the purpose of this Organization to safeguard human lives and minimize damages in case of natural or man-made disasters.
