By the 4<sup>th</sup> Geo: 4, ch: 19, Sect: 1,  
Justices of the peace, throughout  
this Province, shall be bound  
to keep a register of convictions  
by them severally made.

By the 2<sup>d</sup> section - when two  
or more, kept by the Justice.

"Provided that in the C. of  
Q. & M. & Town of 3 Rivers,  
the registers which by this  
act are ordained and  
directed to be kept, shall  
be kept by the Clerks

of the said  
Cities and Towns, respectively,  
as heretofore, and who  
shall account for the  
fees which may be  
imposed according to law,  
by the Justices of the Peace  
in either of the said Cities  
or Towns respectively.

By the 4<sup>th</sup> section, Justices  
of the peace annually, in  
the month of August, to  
transmit & pay over into  
the hands of the Clerk of  
the peace in the City of Montreal

Districts, the amount of all  
fines & penalties by them  
respectively levied & received,  
or not and at the same  
time furnish to such  
clerks of the Peace with  
a statement specifying  
the several offences &c,  
which statements shall  
by the said Clerks of the Peace  
be laid before the several  
sessions of the Peace,  
at the opening of each  
session &c

Duty of the Clerks of the  
Peace, on receipt of fines  
and penalties, to pay
